#### **Along the Red Rock Ridge - Archaeology in a Sacred Landscape**

*Presenter:* Dr. Brian Hoffman (Hamline University)

*Presentation Abstract:* The Red Rock Ridge is an outcrop of Sioux Quartzite that stretches some 20 miles across the prairies and farmlands of southwestern Minnesota. I have been working with a team of archaeologists, historians, naturalists, and American Indian elders to understand the cultural and natural history of this unique landscape. We have documented a diverse range of archaeology sites from ancient stone quarries to astronomical observatories. I will discuss how our collaborative work has transformed our understanding of sacred places and human history.
