Superior National Forest Archaeological Technician GS-0102-5/6 **Duluth, Minnesota** **May/June-October 2020**

The USDA-Forest Service is seeking highly motivated candidates to join our archaeological field crew for the 2020 field season. The positions include GS 5 Archaeological Technicians and a GS6 Archaeological Technician (Crew Leader) based out of the Supervisor's Office in beautiful Duluth, Minnesota. Candidates will have the opportunity to work a flexible schedule and conduct project work throughout the 2.6-million-acre Superior National Forest, including the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness. Fieldwork will require overnight travel from Duluth for up to 50% of the field season. The successful candidate will gain experience in the following areas:

- Assist with pre-field review and designing/implementing Phase I survey in support of diverse undertakings.
- Assist with identification, recordation, and evaluation of a diverse set of historic property types.
- Assist with historic structure maintenance, inventory, field assessments, and National Register evaluations.
- Work with GPS, GIS, LiDar, aerial photo interpretation, and database management.
- Backcountry travel techniques, watercraft safety, canoeing.
